WE ARE BACK!



On our first day, our respected senior ulema and head of the madrasah, Moulana Dr. Abdul Matin Al-Azhari, reminded us to renew our intentions and express heartfelt gratitude to Allah Azzawajjal. He encouraged us to appreciate the immense blessing of being in a special place—a masjid, madrasah, and school—where we have the privilege to recite the Quran daily, pray in jamaat, and deepen our understanding of the life and teachings of the final messenger, Prophet Muhammad .

We listened to a beautiful hadith, where the Prophet Muhammad # advised:




The adhaan was beautifully called by Mustapha in Year 8, Alhamdulillah.

SCHOOL PLAYGROUND APPEAL



JUDO CLUB



We are excited to announce that the school has organised after-school judo sessions at a local judo dojo to encourage pupils to learn this dynamic martial art. Judo offers numerous benefits, including improved physical fitness, discipline, self-defence skills, and enhanced mental focus. It's a fantastic way for students to build confidence and foster a sense of teamwork and respect.

The cost for these sessions is just £25 a month, which covers two sessions each week. For those who book directly through the club, the cost is around £60 a month, making this school offer an incredible value. As a special opening offer, the judo master has graciously agreed that the first five members will only pay £20 for the first month.

Provisional days and timings for the sessions are set for Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4:30pm to 5:30pm. We encourage all interested pupils to take advantage of this wonderful opportunity to learn and grow through judo!



RESIDENTIAL TRIP IN JUNE/JULY









We are very excited to announce that we are provisionally organising a four-day residential trip to Dolgellau, Wales! This adventure will take place either at the end of June or the beginning of July, and we are fortunate to have secured a provisional booking at this extremely popular venue for school groups. Our school will enjoy exclusive use of the facilities, ensuring a unique and tailored experience for our students. To secure this trip, we need at least 30 pupils to sign up, so we would like to encourage you to show your interest by the deadline of 18 November.

Residential courses like this are invaluable parts of the National Curriculum and align perfectly with our school vision of fostering personal development and self-esteem. Students will benefit immensely from this experience, both educationally and socially, with opportunities to enhance their learning in Geography and Science while enjoying the beauty of the natural surroundings.



This year's program promises to be both enjoyable and worthwhile, featuring mini treks, treasure hunts, indoor games, a waterfall trek, a seaside visit, and an optional summit climb to Cader Idris. Additionally, there will be Islamic nasihah sessions designed to uplift students spiritually throughout the trip.

This opportunity is limited to 32 students from Years 7 to 11 on a first-come, first-served basis, with a cost of only £180, which includes transport, accommodation, and food. There are also up to six places available for parents who wish to accompany their child, at a cost of £140.

To confirm your booking, an initial non-refundable deposit of £40 will be required to secure your child's place. The remaining £140 can then be split into three monthly payments of approximately £46.67 each. We look forward to an unforgettable trip filled with learning and adventure!
